The Coquitlam Curling Association is pleased to announce that Coquitlam Mayor and Council at the September 6th Council meeting agreed to defer a decision on ending curling at the Poirier Sport Complex.

It means that no decision has yet been taken on the future of the club and we are hopeful that the Council will look closely at other options and take the view that curling has a lot to offer this community.

Committee members, Barry Ayers, Greg Graham, Earlene Graham have been asked to put a delegation together for the Coquitlam Curling Club's membership's opinions to be heard. We hope by presenting this at a Council committee meeting October 3rd, it will help Council to make an informed decision.

In the meantime, your Executive is working hard behind the scenes to make this a great 2016-17 curling season. As part of our long-term strategy, we are going the extra mile to ensure users have great ice.

- Mike Merklinger, one of BC's best ice makers has been contracted to help install the ice and will be overseeing our City staff icemen in future scheduled maintenance.
- We have facilitated the employment of an additional ice technician to accommodate additional bi weekly ice scrapings.
